Singapore Petroleum Company (SPC)'s First Service Station Opens in Myanmar

SPC-Shwe Taung Energy joint venture plans to invest to provide quality and reliable products and services and create job opportunities in the country

YANGON, Myanmar, 30 March 2019 – The first Singapore Petroleum Company (SPC) service station in Myanmar opened today at the corner of Pyay Road and Dhammadzedi Road in Sanchaung Township, Yangon. This marks SPC's first entry into the retail energy business in Myanmar.

SPC is one of the largest energy companies in Singapore. Founded in 1969, it has interests in oil and gas exploration and production, refining, terminalling and distribution, marketing and trading of crude and refined petroleum products. SPC owns the third largest island-wide retail network of service stations in Singapore.

SPC's entry into Myanmar's retail energy sector is through a joint venture with Shwe Taung Group's Shwe Taung Energy. Shwe Taung Energy operates gasoline and diesel distribution centres across Myanmar.

Customers are promised an enhanced refueling experience at SPC stations in Myanmar. They will enjoy the same premium quality fuel developed by SPC, which are imported directly from its refinery in Singapore. SPC is also invested in prioritising safety at its stations. Designed with a strong focus on safety, SPC stations have in place safety features, such as anti-static staff uniforms and designated walkways, creating a safer refueling environment for Myanmar's motorists.

"We are seeing considerable growth opportunities in the oil and gas retail market in Myanmar. Consumers are become more discerning and sophisticated, and there is an increasing demand for higher quality products and services," said Mr Xia Hongwei, Managing Director of SPC. "A recognised homegrown brand from Singapore, we are committed to develop the SPC brand in Myanmar. We promise to deliver the same added convenience and premium products and services to Myanmar."
