• Additional Precautionary Measures Taken Against COVID-19

YANGON, 19 March 2020 - Pan Pacific Yangon at Junction City confirms that a hotel guest sent for medical assessment for COVID-19 on 17 March 2020 has tested negative for the virus.

On 17 March 2020, the hotel guest informed the hotel that he was feeling unwell. As a precautionary measure, the hotel isolated the guest and arranged for him to go to a hospital for medical assessment. On 19 March 2020, the guest tested negative for COVID-19.

The health and safety of our tenants, guests, visitors and employees is of utmost importance to us. With the global outbreak of COVID-19, we have put in place precautionary measures since early February 2020. These measures include temperature screening, making available hand sanitizers and increased frequency in cleaning common areas. We have also been conducting deep cleaning of Junction City Tower, Junction City Shopping Centre and Pan Pacific Yangon, in addition to our regular and frequent cleaning and sanitising schedules. We will be ramping up our precautionary measures and cleaning protocols in our effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
